After 21 years at Credit Suisse, Moez A. Jamal joined the Board of Directors of Marcuard Family Office in January 2007. During his career at Credit Suisse, he held various senior management positions in Zurich, New York, and London.

From 2004 until 2006, he held the position of Global Treasurer of Credit Suisse & Credit Suisse Group and was a Member of the Investment Committee. He also held the position of Chairman of the Board of Swiss American Securities in New York. From 2002 until 2004, he was part of the Executive Board of Credit Suisse Financial Services and Head of Finance and Products, where he was responsible for delivering investment products and financial solutions to private clients and Swiss corporations. During this period, he also served on the Investment Committee.

From 2000 until 2002, as a Member of the Executive Board of Credit Suisse Private Banking and Head of Investment Products as well as a Member of the Investment Committee, he was primarily responsible for the non-discretionary Asset Management business including the introduction and delivery of alternative investment products and structured advisory products. Prior to coming to Switzerland in 2000, Moez Jamal was in New York from 1993. In 1996, he moved to Credit Suisse First Boston where he was a Managing Director and Member of the Operating Committee in New York in charge of Global Money Markets, Funding and Forward Foreign Exchange. From 1993 to 1996 he was the Treasurer of Credit Suisse in the Americas and Member of the Global Treasury Strategy Committee.

Moez Jamal began his career at Lloyds Bank International in New York in 1980, where he established their derivatives trading desk before joining Credit Suisse in London in 1985.

Mr. Jamal holds an MBA from New York University and a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) degree from Manchester University in England.
